



Jonestown Borough Council Votes to Donate Funds for Fire Equipment

The Northern Lebanon Fire and Emergency Services (NLFES) will receive \$25,000 from Jonestown Borough. On Tuesday, June 7th, Jonestown Borough Council voted unanimously to send a \$25,000 donation to the NLFES to help offset the cost of new air packs for the firefighters. The portable air (not oxygen) tanks with regulators allow firefighters to breathe while in toxic smoke conditions. Usually rated for 30 minutes of service and are used primarily on fires involving structures or hazardous materials.

The Northern Lebanon Fire and Emergency Services is a merger of the Perseverance, Ono, Lickdale and Green Point fire companies. Robert Taylor is the President of the organization. Jonestown will use funds from the Federal American Rescue Act.

“We are grateful we have the funds to help the Department for such a pressing need,” said Council President Tom Keefer.

The funds will partially cover the cost of the new air packs and the NLFES is looking into other funding options.

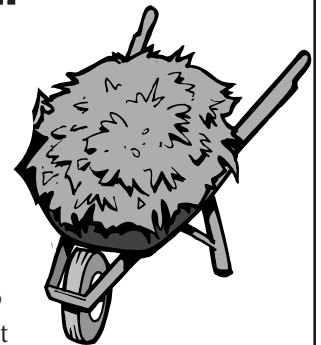

TASA – Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Funding Award

Congratulations Jonestown! Jonestown Borough was awarded \$1,056,500 in federal Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TASA) funding for Market Street Traffic Calming & Pedestrian Safety Projects.

The initial phase of this project will include construction of curb extensions (bulb outs) and enhanced crosswalks at the intersections of W. Market St. and Broad St., E. Market St. and King St. and Market St. and Lancaster St. The bulb outs will help to slow traffic, improve line-of-sight for pedestrians, reduce crossing distance for pedestrians and make the crosswalks & pedestrians more visible to oncoming traffic. Storm water conveyance will also be part of this initial phase. If funding is available, additional phases will include rapid flashing beacon crosswalk lights, as well as several beautification projects as part of the overall Market St. enhancement plan. Phase 1 Project completion targeted for 2024.
